In modern times , people have communicated by letter , telegraph and telephone .But no one method has become as widespread as quickly as the use of email . The first email message took place in 1971, and according to its sender , Ray Tomlinson ,it was probbaly the following : "QWERTYUIOP". What was significant about that ? Nothing , really . This is just the top row of keys on an English-language keyboard . Tomlinson was just testing out the system and using a nonsensense message . He had no concept that he was going to start a revolution in communication . Tomlinson was one of a group of scientists who were working on developing better computers. But there were other computers at other sites where scientists were working on the same project. Tomlinson’s idea was to gure out a way to deliver messages to mailboxes on those remote computers. Let's talk about metal first. Metal is very heavy, it is very hard and strong. It usually feels cool if you touch it. We use metal to make lots of things. We use it for forks , knives, keys, and cars. We use it for these things because it is very strong. Next, let's talk about glass. Glass is very smooth. Last, let's talk about plastic. Plastic is also very light. But it is different from cloth. Sometimes it is soft. And sometimes it is hard. Plastic can be used to make thin plastic bags. These are light, soft, and strong. But plastic can also be used to make bicycle helmets. These are light, hard, and strong. A helmet and a bag seem different. But they are both made from plastic.

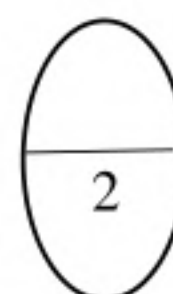

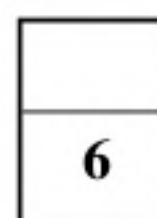
